

SELECTION POLICY FOR 2010 COMMONWEALTH GAMES - TRACK

Re-Issued May 1st, 2010
Effective from March 1, 2010

Note: In case of any wording discrepancies between the English and French versions of the selection policy, the English wording takes precedence.

INTRODUCTION

The Commonwealth Games are scheduled to take place in Delhi, India with the track events scheduled for October 5-8, 2010. The track team will consist of:

- 1 Male - Endurance
- 1 Male – Sprint
- 1 Female – Endurance
- Potentially 1 Female - Sprint

The CCA will select the Commonwealth Games Team from riders participating in the selection camp in LA on July 6 and 7, 2010 and having met the set Selection Criteria listed below. Athletes interested in attending the National Track Team Trials in LA, are asked to e-mail Petrina Tulissi at track@canadian-cycling.com by May 20th, 2010.

The final team selection will be at the discretion of the National coach in agreement with the Track Advisory Committee and the CTO. Upon exhausting the Selection Criteria listed below, the National Team Coach will fill the remaining Team spots based on items mentioned in clause 11.1 in the [Track Selection Policy](#) that is posted on the CCA website (Track > National Team Program).

Objective: To win medals;

Events: The events that will be contested at the Commonwealth Games will be:

Men

- Individual Pursuit
- 1 km Time Trial
- Points Race
- Keirin
- Sprint
- Team Pursuit
- Scratch Race
- Team Sprint

Women

- 500 m Time Trial
- Points Race
- Sprint
- Individual Pursuit
- Team Sprint
- Scratch Race

Eligibility: All elite male and female licensed riders having met clause 5 in the Track Selection Policy posted on the CCA website will be eligible to compete at the Commonwealth Games.

Selection Camp: Athletes will be responsible for the cost and booking of their flights, as well as the cost of their hotel. Flight arrival and departure information should be forwarded to Petrina at track@canadian-cycling.com by June 6th so hotel rooms may be booked. Coaching and track time will be covered by the CCA.

Selection Date: The names of riders selected to the Team will be announced not later than July 8th, 2010.

Automatic selection to the Pool: Athletes who have won a medal at a World Cup during the 2009/10 season or 2010 World Championships have pre-qualified to the Commonwealth Pool and are not obligated to participate in the trials.

Selection Criteria: The fastest times set at the selection camp in LA will be considered when selecting the team to compete at the Commonwealth Games. The team will be decided by the National head coach and Track Selection Advisory Group Members.

Following are some recommended minimum time standards:

*Track times based on 24°C ambient temperature

** Athletes meeting a time standard will be assessed in a team pursuit where full lap times will be used to assess the riders performance in the actual event.

Anticipated Costs: At least 3 spots will be funded for the Commonwealth Games for track athletes. Other athletes who show impressive times at the selection camp, and the potential to be a 2016 Olympic athlete, may be offered a pay-to-play position to benefit from a multi-games experience. In these cases, athletes may be asked to fully fund their travel to the Games.
